










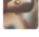



I am a chapter. Why do we need a Library?

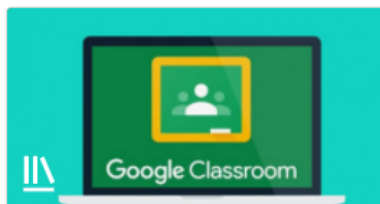
